- J/ABB** *The Secrets of Droon* (series) by Tony Abbott. Eric and his two friends, Neal and Julie, discover a secret doorway in Eric's basement that leads to the rainbow stairs. The stairs reach down into the wondrous world of Droon - a land where all kinds of amazing things occur (120p+).
- J/APP** *The Andalite Chronicles* by Katherine Applegate. Prequel to the "Animorphs" series by this author. Elfangor, an Andalite war-prince, is the one who gives 5 young humans the ability to morph into any animal they touch (326p).
- J/AVI** *Bright Shadow* by Avi. Having used four of the five wishes she is granted, Morwenna flees the kingdom to decide what to do with the last wish. But when the wishes are gone, so is she (167p).
- J/BAB** *The Devil's Other Storybook* by Natalie Babbitt. The devil generally fouls things up in these stories, but sometimes does an unintentional good deed (81p).
Tuck Everlasting. A family's secret of a spring that prevents aging is discovered and they must take drastic measures to protect it (139p).
- J/BAI** *Clabbernappers* by Len Bailey. Eleven-year-old Danny Ray is sent to the kingdom of Elidor, where he sets sail across the Checkered Sea to rescue a kidnapped queen (224p).
- J/BIL** *Well Wished* by Franny Billingsley. 11 year old Nuria tries to outwit the magical wishing well in her mysterious mountain village (170p).
- J/CAR** *Night Gate* by Isobelle Carmody. Seeking a cure for her sick mother, Courage and her dogs pass through a magical gateway to a strange land known as Valley (255p).
- J/CHE** *The Pit* by Ann Cheetham. Oliver enters the body of a boy who lived in 1665 (154p).
- J/CRE** *Time Out* by Helen Cresswell. A family uses a book of magic spells to travel 100 years to the present England (74p).
- J/DAH** Books by Roald Dahl: *The BFG*, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, *James and the Giant Peach*, and *George's Marvelous Medicine*.
- J/DOY** *Groogleman* by Debra Doyle. Strange things are found when Dan tries to rescue the healer (113p).
- J/FLE** *Dragon's Milk* by Susan Fletcher. Kaeldra possesses the power to understand dragons and uses this power to try to save her younger sister (242p).
- J/GRA** *The Wind in the Willows* by Kenneth Grahame. Adventures of four animal friends (254p).
- J/DIN** *Dinotopia* by James Gurney. Will and his father are transported to a land where humans and dinosaurs live together (158p).
- J/JAC** *Redwall* series by Brian Jacques.
- J/JAM** *Shoebag* by Mary James. A boy turns into a cockroach (135p). Also try *Shoebag Returns*.
- J/JAR** *The Fatal Strand* by Robin Jarvis. A mysterious figure becomes a force to be reckoned with as Neil and Edie are caught up in events beyond their control (524p). Also try: *The Raven's Knot* (416p) and *The Woven Path* (409p, book #1 in this series)
- J/JOR** *Secret Sacrament* by Sherryl Jordan. Gabriel is chosen as an Elected One and trained to be a Healer in his Navorran people (338p).
- J/JUS** *The Phantom Tollbooth* by Norton Juster. A gift of a tollbooth takes a boy to many lands (256p).
- J/LAF** *The Forging of the Blade* by R.L. LaFevers. Ten-year-old Kenric leaves the village of Penrith to look for his father who recently has gone missing, and discovers that the evil Lord Mordig is plotting to take over the kingdom (131p).
- J/LAN** *The Fledgling* by Jane Langton. A girl learns to fly with her Goose Prince (182p).
- J/LAS** *The Capture* by Kathryn Lasky. After he falls from his nest, Soren the owl is captured. He must escape to find his

- family and warn the world about the dangers of St. Aegolius (226p).
- J/LEE ***Black Unicorn*** by Tanith Lee. 16 year old Tanaquil reconstructs a unicorn that comes to life and leads her to the way to a perfect world (138p).
- J/LEN ***A Wrinkle in Time*** by Madeleine L'Engle. A girl and her friends become involved with unearthly strangers when they search for her father who has disappeared. Also try: ***A Wind in the Door*** (211p)
- J/LEV ***Ella Enchanted*** by Nancy Levine. A Cinderella story in which Ella struggles against a curse that forces her to obey any order given to her (232p).
- J/LEW ***The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe*** series by C.S. Lewis.
- J/LOW ***The Giver*** by Lois Lowry. When Jonas becomes the "Receiver of Memories" in his community, he discovers the terrible truth about the society he lives in (180p).
- J/MAC ***Tomorrow's Wizard*** by Patricia MacLachlan. Six short stories about a wizard, an apprentice, and their horse (66p).
- J/MCC ***The Stones are Hatching*** by Geraldine McCaughrean. 11 year old Phelim and his companions take a journey to destroy the dangerous Worm and its Hatchlings (230p).
- J/MCK ***The Hero and the Crown*** by Robin McKinley. Aerin wins the birthright due her as the daughter of the Damarian king and a witchwoman of the mysterious, demon-haunted North (246p).
- J/MCM ***The New Kid at School*** by Kate McMullan. Book one in the ***Dragon Slayers' Academy*** series. Wiglaf is off to Dragon Slayers' Academy and in for a first day of school he will never forget (91p).
- J/NOR ***The Borrowers*** by Mary Norton. Little people in a house borrow things from humans (180p).
- J/PEC ***Seal Child*** by Sylvia Peck. A girl is transformed into a seal (200p).
- J/PET ***The Littles Have a Wedding*** by John Lawrence Peterson. A family of tiny people celebrate the wedding of cousin Dinky (95p).
- J/PHI ***REM World*** by W.R. Philbrick. An 11 year old, attempting to escape a hurtful nickname, is transported to an endangered dream world (192p).
- J/PRA ***Truckers*** by Terry Pratchett. A story of several gnomes who live in a department store and their move to a new home (246p).
- J/ROB ***Spellfall*** by Katherine Roberts. 12 year old Natalie is kidnapped by a wizard and she, her step-brother, and their friends attempt to save another world (250p).
- J/ROD ***Freaky Friday*** by Mary Rodgers. A 13 year old girl and her mother must spend a day in each other's bodies (145p).
- J/RUB ***Under the Cat's Eye: a tale of morph and mystery*** by Gillian Rubenstein. Jai and his friends at a boarding school join forces with shape-shifters to save the school (204p).
- J/RUP ***The Dragon of Lonely Island*** by Rebecca Rupp. Three children spend the summer with their mother on a secluded island where they discover a three-headed dragon living in a cave (160p).
- J/SAG ***Magyk*** by Angie Sage. After learning that she is the Princess, Jenna is whisked from her home and carried toward safety by the Extraordinary Wizard (564p).
- J/STE ***Beyond the Deepwoods*** by Paul Stewart. Thirteen-year-old Twig, having always looked and felt different from his woodtroll family, learns that he is adopted. To find out where he belongs, Twig wanders into the mysterious, dangerous world beyond the deepwoods (278p).
- J/TOL ***The Hobbit*** by J.R.R. Tolkien. A saga of dwarfs, elves, goblins, and trolls in a far off land (304p). Also try ***The Lord of the Rings*** trilogy.
