Library Building Will Reopen on Monday, June 29, 2020

- The library will resume original hours and be open to an occupancy of 30 patrons.
- **All patrons/ staff must adhere to state requirements or guidance, such as face masks must be worn for anyone above the age of two, and people must maintain social distancing.**
- Short stays are encouraged and a time limit of one hour may be necessary if capacity is consistently being reached.
- Computer use limit will be one hour. Patrons must practice social distancing and wear face masks.
- Seating and Social areas, toys, and office supplies will not be available.
- Patrons can browse materials, carts will be available for items that have been touched.
- Curbside service will continue for patrons who prefer not to enter. Weather permitting curbside hours will be Monday Through Thursday 10-6 and Friday/ Saturday 10-4.
- Circulation Services: Patrons may come in for in person pick up and card registration/renewal.
- Patron Services: Copy/ fax services will be available. Adult/ Youth Reference staff will be available for questions.
